### WHITE

#### MUSCADET LA PÉCHERIE, DOMAINE JÉRÉMIE HUCHET, LOIRE, FRANCE 2023

I'm writing this from my desk in Padstow with a view across the Camel estuary the tide is in, and on the other side I can see the Porthilly oyster baskets in the distance and I'm salivating at the thought of my favourite food and wine match, Muscadet and Oysters. Muscadet is an electric shock of a wine, buzzing with fresh acidity and refreshing saline citrus fruit, when teamed with those gorgeous briny, salty, metallic fruits of the sea then you get the perfect combo.

#### GRÜNER VELTLINER, VOM HAUS, WEINGUT PFAFFL, AUSTRIA 2024

Designed to be drunk fresh and young. Notes of green apple, conference pear and pineapple combine with the classic pepperiness of Grüner Veltliner, all underpinned by a fresh and zesty acidity.

#### GARGANEGA SAUVIGNON BLANC CHARDONNAY, ANSELM SAN VICENZO IGT, VENETO, ITALY 2024

Fruity, youthful style, reminiscent of hazelnuts and peaches. No wood maturation just clean crisp flavours with a long finish.

#### SEMENTE ALVARINHO, VINHO VERDE DOC, PORTUGAL 2023

Vinho Verdes are getting better and better, this goes so well with shellfish. Very fresh apple and citrus aromas, delicate clean and crisp.

#### SALT RIVER, SAUVIGNON BLANC, SAVAGE, STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA 2024

SA's very own Mr Sauvignon Blanc, Duncan Savage, has crafted here a wonderful, scintillating modern Savvy using grapes from a wind-blown 32-year-old vineyard in Stellenbosch. Cape gooseberry, quince and peach tea scents with a tight, nervy, salty finale.

#### RIESLING, TROCKEN, MAXIMIN GRÜNHaus, MOSEL, GERMANY 2023

Spontaneous fermentation gives an exciting tension expressing flavours reminiscent of ripe apricots, peaches, orange zest and tropical fruit on the nose. The palate shows complexity, a crisp character and excellent length with long lingering fruit.

**STEIN'S BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR ROUGE, FRANCE 2018**

Stein's Bordeaux is our own blend of Merlot and Cabernet created with the help of our friends in the south of Bordeaux. It's a soft and juicy claret that is exactly the right wine to go with a steak frites or a plate of cheese.

**PINOT NOIR, SOLI, THRACIAN VALLEY, BULGARIA 2021**

Bulgaria might not be the first place that comes to mind when thinking of quality Pinot Noir, however in a sheltered little vineyard on the eastern side of the Thracian Valley, Italian winemaker Edoardo Miroglio is crafting delicious, juicy, perfumed pinot. I've tried this blind against many different pinot noirs from around the world and I was convinced it was a Santenay from Burgundy - and I wasn't the only one in the group. The wine is light, fresh, fragrant with redcurrant and wild strawberry fruit and it's dangerously easy to drink.

**BARBERA D'ALBA LA GEMELLA, VIBERTI GIOVANNI, PIEDMONTE, ITALY 2023**

Lighter in body but loaded with favour, this bright and pretty Barbera punches well above its weight and has that typical Italian flare to boot.

WHITE

**LA ROSA, DOURO DOC, PORTUGAL 2023**

This complex wine has succulent white fruit, herb & tropical fruit aromas with a racy citrus acidity to finish.

**MALVASIA, 'ANCESTRALE', CANTINA ORSOLOGNA, ABRUZZO, ITALY 2024 (ORANGE WINE)**

From the consistently impressive Cantina Orsogna in Abruzzo this is an outstanding example of a white wine made in the way red wines are made (loads of skin contact) which makes for the orange colour (and name). It is fresh and full of mango and pineapple flavours balanced impeccably with acidity and a texture which makes for a very pleasant introduction to the orange wine style.

**GEWÜRZTRAMINER, ROLLY GASSMANN, ALSACE, FRANCE 2019**

Full, balanced and very aromatic. Depending on the vintage, the principal aromas of Gewürztraminer are lychee, rose, ginger and geranium. The Rolly Gassmann is off dry and shows classic restraint, without any loss of the Gewürztraminer's exotic and spicy feature.

**ABYSS, ASSIRTYKO, NEMA PELOPONNESE, GREECE 2021**

This is the estates top cuvee made from 100% Assyrtiko, which is best known for being the indigenous variety of Santorini. With a brilliant bright straw colour, the wine introduces you to distinct aromas of exotic fruit with notes of honeysuckle. The palate shows fresh citrus fruit with smooth round body and a richly complex texture with an elegant finish.

**TABLAS CREEK VINEYARD ROUSSANNE, PASO ROBLES, CALIFORNIA, USA 2019**

This 100% Roussanne is produced by the same family that owns Château Beaucastel in the Rhône. Rich aromas of lacquered wood, new honey, orange peel with a creamy caramel & ripe pear finish.

**GARRUS, CHÂTEAU D'ESCLANS, CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE 2021**

Widely regarded as one of the best rosés, Garrus from Château d'Esclans has tightly wound power with bold strawberry, white peach and floral aromatics. There's a broad, textural feel on the palate, and a reductive note, more akin to a white burgundy, that builds to a long, graceful, saline finish.

Summer was not especially warm, but a hot, dry September pushed the raisins through the final phase of ripening. The blend is 81% Cabernet Sauvignon and 19% Merlot.

The duo of Sauvignon and Gros-Manseng will seduce you with its intense notes of exotic and citrus fruits, with a streak of minerality and freshness.

Clean and crisp it is bursting with a flinty minerality with flavours of grapefruit, gooseberry, herbs and white stone fruit. Expressive on the palate, finishing with great length. This fashionable white wine is a benchmark by which New World Sauvignons are judged.

**ROSÉ WINE**

**CHÂTEAU BAUDUC ROSÉ, BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2024**

This dry rosé was made from equal parts of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. The grapes were harvested earlier in September than for making red, and the pale juice quickly run off the dark skins for a light, crisp wine.

**CÔTES DE PROVENCE, MIRAVAL, PROVENCE, FRANCE 2024**

The wine has a beautiful pale, petal-pink colour, with bright nuances. On the nose, it has aromas of fresh redcurrants, lemons and spring flowers. It finishes with a refreshing acidity, minerality and a saline finish.

**WHISPERING ANGEL, CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE 2024**

Meet the world's trendiest Provence pink, made by Sacha Lachine, a master of the art of rosé. In 2006, he took over Château d'Esclans. His vision was to create some of the world's greatest wine. To do so, he introduced ground-breaking winemaking techniques, this revolutionised Provence rosé - with Whispering Angel as the figurehead. It has fresh notes of apple, pink grapefruit, peach, cream and a long smooth finish.

**TARAPACA MERLOT, D.O. VALLE CENTRAL, CHILE 2024**

Merlot from Chile. Medium bodied with notes of ripe red fruits & subtle hints of sweet spice.

**SYRAH, DOMAINE DE CASTELNAU GARENNE, IGP D'OC, LANGUEDOC, FRANCE 2023**

It's not Jean-Louis Chave Hermitage but neither does it want to be (actually, it does remind us a bit of the Northern Rhone). It wants to give you simple, uncomplicated pleasure, that's every bit as delicious as the wine itself. And there's nothing wrong - in fact, there's everything right - with that.

**GARNACHA, RICK STEIN'S SPANISH RED, CAMPO DE BORJA, SPAIN 2022**

**RIOJA CRIANZA, GRAN DOMINO, SPAIN 2021**

Gran Domino are a consistently excellent winery, they make their Rioja in a truly classical style with plenty of oak. It's round and supple with savoury red fruit, warming spice and some vanilla



from the oak. It's a real Sunday-roast-in-your-favourite-cosy-pub-with-the-fire-roaring type of wine.
